New CRC/CCRC Continuing Education Tools Help Save Time and Money!

CRCC has developed two new tools to assist CRCs and CCRCs in planning their continuing education (CE) as they prepare to renew their certification.

CRC/CCRC Continuing Education, A Guide To Meeting Your Requirements is a helpful, "at-a-glance" checklist that highlights the types of programs and activities that qualify for CRC/CCRC CE credit as well as the corresponding number of eligible CE hours. It also provides money-saving tips to help proactively manage and minimize continuing education costs. All CRCs and CCRCs are encouraged to check if they have already completed activities that may qualify for CE credit.

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Providers may offer programs that are NOT pre-approved. Non-pre-approved programs may qualify for CE credit but require a separate submission process.

CRC/CCRC Continuing Education (CE) Providers with Pre-Approved Programs is a list of providers that offer one or more programs that have been reviewed and approved by CRCC as qualifying for CRC/CCRC CE credit. Pre-approved CE programs save time and money as they require less paperwork and no submission fee. The list is provided in Excel format so it may be easily sorted across a variety of dimensions including provider and method of instruction. The list also provides vendor contact information, specifically phone number and/or website URL.

Providers on this list may also offer programs that are NOT pre-approved for CRC/CCRC CE credit, but may qualify on a post-approval basis. Submission for post approval CE requires an

additional form and processing fee. CRCs and CCRCs should contact providers directly for program details and to verify pre-approval status.
